



## News & Prayer Tidbits

- The Lord provided for Jubilee in a tremendous way during December! In January when we received our monthly transfer of donations, we found enough money to completely come up to date on ALL our utility bills and contractor payments for work that had been completed. Give God the glory due Him!
- The provision was so perfectly timed as the van broke down and required extensive repair due to a broken timing belt. This too was able to be repaired and is again running.
- Many of our girls are listed by the Romanian government as mentally handicapped. Each year they must be re-evaluated. This years evaluation went well. In addition to all of them being re-certified, about half were given permanent status. This means less running around for evaluations.
- The liquidation process is nearly complete. We expect that the courts will provide us with the final sign off in the coming 3-4 weeks! Please pray that there will be no complications. This process will finalize the legal transfer of Inasmuch to Jubilee.
- Pray for several of our girls that have lost their jobs or still need to get a job.
- Vasi, Nelu's wife has joined him full-time in his work for Jubilee. While this is a great blessing for the girls, it is also indicative of the fact that their home business is no longer able to support them. Pray that the Lord would see to their needs.
- Pray for the Lord's provision for Jubilee. We are presently still in a mode of projected shortfall in meeting the costs of operation.
- Tim Bale and family are preparing to join ministry with Jubilee, perhaps as early as May or June of 2010! Please pray that the Lord would continue to open the doors and provide for them.

In our [December newsletter](#) we gave a snapshot of our monthly budget costs, many took notice that one line item was titled "Loredana Support" and several folks have asked "Who is Loredana?"

Loredana is a sweet young girl who was born to young canal dwelling street-kids 10 years ago. Loredana's natural parents have had other children, some we know of and others that perhaps we don't. The last we heard, they were no longer together. Her older brother Leonard we do know of and he has been taken in by a family in Bucharest.

Loredana's mother stayed for a short time in the Mothers and Babies house that Ron and Sue Bates ran. Upon that ministry closing down, her mother realized that she could not properly care for her and sought a good family to adopt her. In 2005 God sent a father and mother for His precious child, the adopting family is Rroma, and not very wealthy by any means. We have believed that it was God's providence for Loredana that she should
